

APRIL 14<sup>TH</sup> BOARD MEETING  
WINTER SPORTS RECOMMENDATIONS

MEMBERSHIP TOTALS AS OF 4/13 WAS 3300, WITH 3100 BEING GOLD CARDS

MARV TALKED ABOUT THE BANQUET COMING UP ON MAY 23<sup>RD</sup>....IN EUGENE. SHARED THE WINTER COACHES OF THE YEAR THAT WILL BE HONORED AT THE BANQUET.

A VOLLEYBALL CLINIC UPDATE WAS GIVEN BY KIM MCLAIN. OACA WILL JOIN WITH OSU WHO WILL BRING IN 3 HS COACHES TO SPEAK GOING ON ITS 4<sup>TH</sup> YEAR. WILL BE HELD ON JULY 24 & 25. KIM WILL BE ONE OF THE "FEATURED SPEAKERS".

DAVE REPORTED THAT THE NIKE FOOTBALL CLINIC WAS DOWN ABOUT 15 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR. IT'S STILL THE 2<sup>ND</sup> OR 3<sup>RD</sup> LARGEST THE COUNTRY.

DENNIS MURPHY TALKED ABOUT THE BASKETBALL CLINIC THAT WAS HELD AT WESTVIEW HS ON OCTOBER 10<sup>TH</sup>. IT WAS SPONSORED BY NIKE, OACA.....125 COACHES ATTENDED....VERY SUCCESSFUL FOR A FIRST TIME. BIG HOOK WAS TO GO INTO THE NIKE EMPLOYEE STORE. HOPE TO BRING IN MORE HS COACHES.....MORE 4A-1A COACHES ATTENDED BUT NEED TO GET OUR 5A & 6A THERE. TALKED ABOUT ADDING A WOMAN SPEAKER. THERE WASN'T A LOT OF NOTICE FOR THE CLINIC. WILL WORK ON GETTING THE INFORMATION OUT SOONER FOR NEXT YEAR.

ROB MENTIONED THAT JOHN BECK WAS ONE OF OUR NIKE CLINIC SPEAKERS WHOSE PRESENTATION WAS PUBLISHED IN THE NATIONAL MANUAL FOR ALL NIKE COY CLINICS.

MARK HENDERSON REPORTED ON THE CLASSIFICATION MEETING. MAJORITY STILL IN FAVOR OF THE 6 CLASSIFICATIONS. WITH TALK OF THE HYBRID.....A LOT OF QUESTIONS REGARDING THE HYBRID AND HOW IT WORKS. A SAMPLE SCHEDULE IS GOING TO BE SHOWN AT THE OADA CONFERENCE GIVING A SAMPLE HYBRID SCHEDULE. NEXT CLASSIFICATION MEETING IN SUNRIVER ON MON. FINAL DECISION TO BE DONE IN OCTOBER.
